

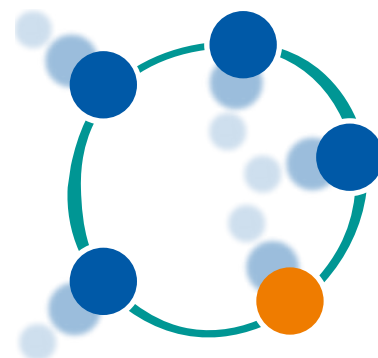
# conference newsletter

Another month has passed and the EADI General Conference “Responsible Development in a Polycentric World: Inequality, Citizenship and the Middle Classes” is only a stone’s throw away. In order to share more information on the conference itself and the logistics connected to this big event, we would like to provide you with the following information today:

## 1. Upcoming deadlines

Even though the start of the EADI General Conference is merely 70 away, a number of deadlines will have to be met in that short period of time:

- 22 April:** Until this date, the Working Group Conveners will have reviewed the submitted papers for their conference sessions. Immediately afterwards, the authors will be notified about the full acceptance of their papers. Do not stress out if the conveners want you to work on your paper, there is a little time put aside for that!
- 02 May:** All authors will have to submit their final papers by this date. This deadline does not only apply to the authors who will present during EADI Working Group sessions but also to presenters of the panel sessions. Authors are kindly asked to use the [conference cover page](#) and attach it to their document. Please access ConfTool to upload your final paper both in .doc/.docx and .pdf.
- 15 May:** This is the day when the conference team is putting together the final programme. All changes – may it be in abstracts, titles, papers and participants’ names and personal information – need to be sent to the conference team and/or updated on ConfTool.
- 31 May:** Until this date you can register for the conference for the prices mentioned on the conference website. Afterwards, all fees will be raised by 50€. After all, spaces for the full conference package are limited, take advantage of the offer while it lasts and check the conference website for other options such as registering for one or two days!
- 23 June:** The very final deadline marks the day of the start of the four-day conference! We are very excited to welcome you at the conference centre.
